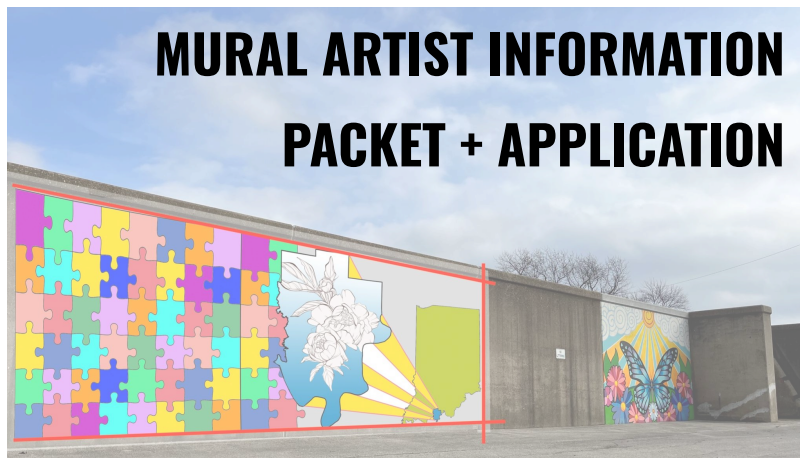
Coming June 2023, the Floodwall at Sunset Park, Tell City will be getting a newly painted addition. Plans for the **"Why We #pickperry" Community Collaboration Mural** features nature, activities and

landmarks of Perry County, Indiana. This mural is brought to you by Tell City Regional Arts and Colleen Reed. We are seeking individual artists from Perry and surrounding counties, as well as sponsorship from small businesses and local corporations.

When completed, the mural will resemble a 48 count jigsaw puzzle spotlighting tourism and attractions from Perry County. "Why We #pickperry" Community Collaboration Mural

In most community murals, an artist designs a sketch, and the painters can participate matching a color to a predestined space. In this mural, we are giving over the regions to YOU as an artist. The puzzle mural will contain 48 MINI MURALS, each "painting" approximately 20x24". We are letting painters pick from a list of subjects that reflect our beloved Perry County, Indiana.

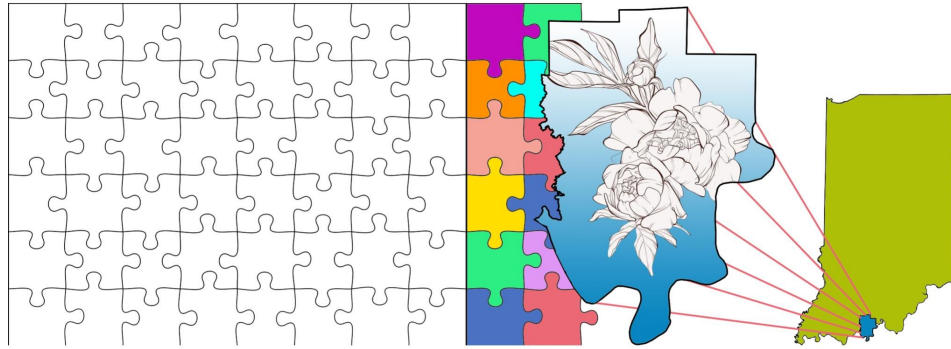
Do you need to have mural experience? NOPE! Hobbyists and Pros are welcome here, the finished piece is the size of an average canvas.

How do I participate? EASY! Fill out an application to start the process with us. You will pick a puzzle piece, a theme to paint, and receive more information from there!

Do I have to live in Perry County? Nope, but you should! Just kidding, we are welcoming all artists that wish to participate.

PUZZLE FLOODWALL MURAL / PUZZLE PIECE BID PROCESS

INDIVIDUAL MURAL ARTIST

1. Mini murals are approximately 20 x 24” spots - The painter pays \$75 to **claim their puzzle piece** and to begin the application / approval process.
2. Puzzles will be split into “painting height” categories. WHY? If you are a short human and afraid of heights, you can choose the ground level to be comfortable painting.
 - a. Scaffolding / man lift (top)
 - b. 10 ‘ man ladder (middle)
 - c. Ground level / short stool (bottom)
3. The artist must **pick a theme** from our approved list on the application. Themes are reserved on a first come, first serve basis, as we are not allowing duplicate scenes.
4. A **Concept painting** must be submitted for final approval to participate by April 30, 2023.
 - a. ½ scale, full rendering and the same shape as the jigsaw selected
 - b. painted on foam core in acrylic paints
 - c. foam core puzzle piece base is provided by TCRA and will be displayed at an indoor installation at Tell City Regional Arts gallery.
5. **Sign up for a painting day time slot** at the artwork approval meeting. Our kickoff painting weekend is Saturday, **June 10, 2023**.
6. The artist can bring their own exterior paint colors or use ours provided
7. We recommend painters to use their own brushes, but we will have some available
8. The artist may sign the bottom right corner, approximately 3x6” maximum size
9. The painters’ names will be included on a recognition plaque next to finished mural
